NASDSE TRADITIONS

- Wisconsin State Night will take place at the Harley-Davidson Museum, about a mile away from the
 conference hotel. Shuttle buses will be available to transport those attending. Please note that you
 must register for State Night, either by choosing Level I registration or purchasing a separate ticket.
- NASDSE has a long tradition of hosting a Silent Auction at its annual conference, the proceeds of
 which are used to support training for new state directors. The Silent Auction is open to all conference
 attendees, so be sure to remember to pack your contribution to this fun opportunity.
- President's Reception: NASDSE will host an Installation of Officers, Awards Ceremony and President's Reception at the close of the conference on Tuesday, September 27th. Please note that you must register for the Reception, either by choosing Level 1 registration or purchasing a separate ticket.
- There will not be Sponsor Showcases at this year's conference but we are expecting many more sponsors who are participating in the conference in a variety of ways. Be sure to visit their booths while you are at the conference.

CONFERENCE ATTIRE
